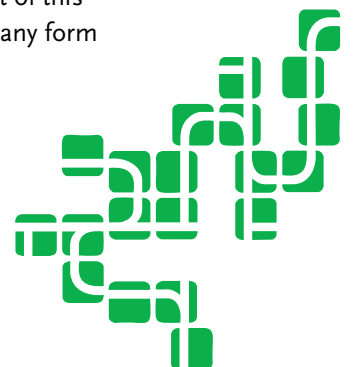

Introduction

This document describes how to install the Document Viewer and Document List modules on a running installation of the Synkron Via CMS. These modules will add new and more performance friendly document handling functionality to the installation.

Purpose and functionality

The purpose of the Document Viewer module is to display one specific document on a page on the basis of a parameter identifier.

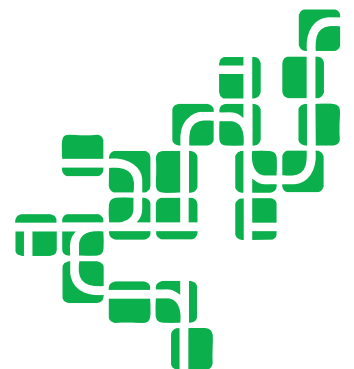
The Purpose of the Document List module is to display lists of content from fields extracted from a document or a range of documents.

Combined these two modules succeeds the Document Publisher module as they constitute a radical improvement to the functionality of that module.

Installation package

The installation package consists of three files:

- DocumentList.dll
- DocumentViewer.dll
- UpdateDocumentDatabase.exe



Installing and setting up

To install the modules perform a standard installation in the workspace area.

1. In the Workspace area open the Manage Add-ons window via **Administrator -> System Tools -> Manage Add-ons**.
2. Browse for each .dll and install.

Notice that for system installations running live websites we recommend performing all install/uninstall operations in periods with low traffic to avoid facing website users with unhandled errors.

Upon installation

Upgraded Via installations originally dating back to before version 2.2 may experience data inconsistencies in image references on documents. To avoid problems run the UpdateDocumentDatabase.exe file.

1. Copy UpdateDocumentDatabase.exe to the Bin folder on the server that holds the installation. Execute the file.
2. In the command prompt that opens input Username and Password to the administrator account.

Installation and setup is complete.
